The Bighorn National Forest plans to eliminate the District Ranger stationed fulltime in Buffalo. Rather the Forest Supervisor intends to have a “full time” District Ranger who will be in Buffalo a couple of days a week. Not full time by most people’s definition of full time.

On April 19 from 4 to 6 PM, Andrew Johnson, recently arrived Bighorn National Forest Supervisor, will be holding an Open House at the Powder River Ranger District Office at 1415 Fort Street.

Come and share with him the need for a truly full time District Ranger stationed in Buffalo. If the full time District Ranger goes, eventually the rest of the Forest Service staff could fade away through relocation, retirement or resignations. A District Ranger and their staff in Buffalo are vital for the management of the southern portion of the Bighorn National Forest.
