

The Circle



The Circle is the first complete and enclosed shape (without angles) within unilateral distance from its center to each of its inner sides.

The Circle as a symbol can carry many meanings and can be associated with different definitions.

My personal use of the circle can vary in its definition but I usually use a constant.

Unity, wholeness, protection, enclosure, Sun (as the star), individuality, boundaries, limitation, repeating cycle, none evolution.


Example



Top circle which is representing your energy, draw the line from below the circle down. ...

Now, from the top of ascended line, go with a semicircle and kind of enclosed the second smaller circle.

The Triangle



The Triangle is the first complete and enclosed shape (with angles).


The Triangle as a symbol can carry many meanings and can be associated with different definitions.

My personal use of the triangles can vary in its definitions allowing much flexibility.

△ Fire, masculine energy, action, force, direction, trinity, focus, first stable base.

▽ Water, feminine energy, calm, air, inward.
Each side of the triangle provides support and balance to the other sides, creating a stable framework.

Example



The current position of this symbol is activating a more feminine energy because of the emotional translation...

That "gut feeling" is the translation of an energy and we call that Intuition.

The Square



The Square is the second complete and enclosed shape (with angles) which has all sides at same length.

The square shape can have many meanings but the most relevant ones in our practice is the energetical ones rather than practical meanings.

Stability, equilibrium, solid base, completeness, equality, foundation, strength

Square shape is associated with number 4 because the formed square is the perfect balance between 4 points.

4 is in our awareness under different aspects like 4 cardinal points, 4 elements, 4 seasons... all representative of equilibrium and diversity.

Sigil of Power

The sigil construction is using the name of Archangel Michael (same symbol-construction is associated with Sunday, the day of the Sun) positioned in the 4 cardinal points of the inner circle.


Dascent - 6th Grid



6th Grid is derived from platonic solids shape.
 Cube, or Hexahedron, has 6 sides, and is made of squares. It is a kind of prism

Can be used as a construction pattern for sigil work.

Use one of the two centers according to the intent.
